

Project Management Professional (PMP)® Exam Preparation

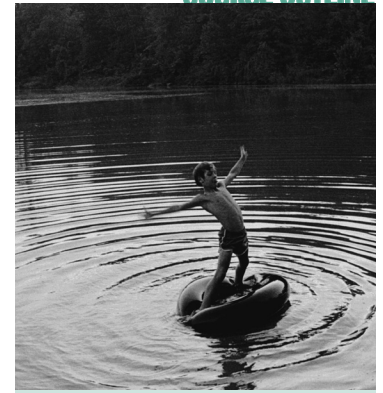
